We will actively seek to build a positive culture that places safety at the forefront of all that we do while recognising we must always strive to improve.

We will comply with all legislative requirements, recognised standards, codes of practice and safe operating procedures.

We will seek to understand and eliminate health and safety hazards and risks where reasonably practicable and where this is not possible seek to minimize those risks.

We will work closely with our contracting partners and others who our activities influence to create a shared view of critical risks and an aligned understanding of the steps needed to reduce or eliminate those critical risks.

We will support our people to take these commitments to health and safety beyond our work environment and support the wider community. We will do this through active engagement of our people and by providing appropriate instruction, skills, and training.

We will establish processes to protect, foster, support and reclaim the mental health and wellbeing of our people.

We will establish and communicate strategies and objectives to ensure we focus on the right things and continually improve our health and safety and public safety management systems.

We know we can achieve excellence in the management of health and safety, emergency management, employee wellness and rehabilitation.
