



ELECTRICITY CAN JUMP

Look up before you tip that load, pick up that ladder or raise that scissor lift. Overhead power lines might be closer than you think.

Electricity can 'jump' through the air, so you don't even need to touch a power line to get seriously hurt – or worse. That's why safe is a 4 metre word. It's the minimum safe distance to keep from our power lines and other equipment.

Getting too close risks electric shock, power cuts and project delays.

If you want to work closer than 4 metres, talk to us about a close approach consent.
